## What's an Environmental Merit Award?

The Narragansett Bay Commission (NBC) is proud to announce the twenty-second annual NBC Environmental Merit Awards program. Through this program the NBC offers three types of Environmental Merit Awards: the NBC **Pollution Prevention Award** which honors (a) companies that have demonstrated efforts that go above and beyond NBC regulatory compliance requirements using pollution prevention techniques/technologies and (b) organizations or individuals that have helped promote pollution prevention and regulatory compliance within the regulatory community; the NBC **Perfect Compliance Award** which is given to each Significant Industrial User that achieves perfect compliance with all NBC regulatory requirements during the previous calendar year, and the NBC **Stormwater Management Award** which is given to companies, organizations or individuals that successfully use Best Management Practices to minimize stormwater impacts on the NBC sewer collection system.

## How do we qualify for an award?

To qualify for a Pollution Prevention Award a company must be located within the NBC service district, must be in good standing with all NBC rules and regulations and must be able to demonstrate pollution prevention efforts that have resulted in any combination of results outlined in the awards criteria section of this application package.

To qualify for a Stormwater Management Award a company or organization must be located within the NBC service district and must demonstrate stormwater abatement efforts that result in the measurable reduction/elimination of stormwater flow to the NBC sewer system.

Individuals and/or organizations not directly involved with the implementation of pollution prevention activities may be eligible for an Environmental Merit Award based upon their efforts and actions to educate and motivate an industrial sector or individual company to utilize pollution prevention and to better comply with environmental regulations.

Significant Industrial Users that have achieved perfect compliance with all NBC regulatory and permit requirements during the last calendar year will be notified by NBC of their eligibility to receive a Perfect Compliance Award. There is no need to apply for the prestigious Perfect Compliance award.

## What are the criteria for an award?

The following criteria will be used to evaluate each applicant for the Pollution Prevention and Stormwater Management Awards:

- Volume/toxicity reduction of pollutants
- Reduction of Stormwater flow
- Practical reuse of stormwater
- Benefits to workers and the community
- Demonstrated commitment to sound environmental management practices
- Application of pollution prevention/stormwater management efforts for use by other companies
- Employee participation
- Extraordinary efforts to go beyond compliance and/or demonstrate innovative approaches to waste management

## Why should my company participate?

Recipients will receive an award and certificate and be acknowledged in an NBC publication. In addition, an advertisement in a statewide newspaper will highlight the winners.
